You will support social, emotional and behavioural needs as well as their learning within the classroom. The role would involve delivering flexible and proactive interventions, led by the teacher to support the child and secure progress. You should have an appreciation and empathy for trauma informed behaviours and be prepared to use emotion coaching, de-escalation strategies and where necessary, positive handling techniques (you will be trained for this). Ideally the candidate would be able to deliver specific interventions over short periods (including 1:1 and small group work).

You will also be a key adult supporting a child with Diabetes and full training will be provided.

You should offer:

- experience of working with children with challenging behaviour and emotions
- a calm, positive, consistent and patient approach to supporting children
- experience of supporting learning within the classroom
- the ability to work well as part of a team.
- the ability to adapt to change
