#### Take-Art project

We are excited to have been one of only four settings in Somerset and Dorset to take part in a project with 'Take Art '. The pilot of this project will begin this term and Artists will be in our setting working with staff and children on two dates in May / June; Friday 30<sup>TH</sup> June and Friday 6<sup>th</sup> June. The projects theme is; Inside Outside. Working alongside children to design and build outdoor enclosures. Inviting children to explore intangible concepts such as: shadows, reflections, the colour spectrum, delicate and noisy sounds.
