#### Collective Worship listening music 22-23

Equality and diversity is promoted in the music curriculum by exposing the children to music from a variety of periods and styles. The children listen to each song at the start and end of each assembly. They learn more information about the song and questions are asked to develop their music knowledge further.

## KS1 NC aim - To listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music.

Specific learning objectives for each year group:

Reception - Listen to music and respond by using hand and whole body movements.

Year 1 - Reflect on music and say how it makes people feel, act and move.

Year 2 - Notice how music can be used to create different moods and effects and to communicate ideas.

# KS2 NC aim - To appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians.

Specific learning objectives for each year group:

Year 3 - Begin to recognise and identify instruments being played.

Year 4 - Begin to recognise and identify instruments and the number of instruments being played.

Year 5 - Evaluate different kinds of music using appropriate musical vocabulary.

Year 6 - Analyse and compare musical features choosing appropriate musical vocabulary.

(Music vocabulary: pulse, rhythm, pitch, tempo, dynamics, texture, structure)
